

Terms & Conditions

- 1. By registering yourself or your child in an Odyssey Sports clinic, camp or workshop you acknowledge acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- 2. Odyssey Sports has the right to refuse participation to any participant who is displaying dangerous behaviour or disrupting the learning or experience for other participants.
- 3. If you (parent/guardian) cannot be contacted in the case of an illness or accident you authorise us to seek any medical, hospital or ambulance services as we see fit and you agree to meet all expenses involved.
- 4. You acknowledge that Odyssey Sports retains enrolment information on a confidential database. You authorise Odyssey Sports to use this information to send you marketing information. You can unsubscribe from these at any time.
- 5. You acknowledge that the activities taken part in while participating in Odyssey Sports camps, clinics or workshops may involve some risk. While all care is taken by Odyssey Sports to provide a safe program we shall not be liable for any personal injury, damage to property, loss or liability suffered by any participant or any participant's parent or guardian arising from or in relation to the enrolment in our program unless caused by the proven negligence or wilful misconduct of Odyssey Sports.
- 6. When attending camps and clinics your child will participate in activities relevant to the program booked such as tumbling, stunting and cheerleading skills or ninja and parkour activities. Participants may take part in activities such as (without limitation) swimming, dancing, camp activities (flying fox, giant swing, rock climbing) which involve anticipated and unanticipated risks. Neither Odyssey Sports or any third party suppling facilities or services in relation to these activities shall be liable for any personal injury, damage to property, loss or liability suffered by any participant arising from or in relation to these activities.
- 7. You agree to Odyssey Sports using photographs or videography of you or your child for marketing and publicity purposes unless otherwise advised in writing prior to the camp or clinic being attended.
- 8. By enrolling in Odyssey Sports online classes you agree to have the session recorded for insurance purposes.
- 9. You willingly agree to comply with Odyssey Sports events stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If you observe any unusual significant concern in your child's readiness for participation and/ or in the workshop itself, you will remove your child from the participation and bring such attention of the nearest official immediately.
- 10. Participants must respect all venue and facility rules and regulations.
- 11. Participants must obey all rules and regulations set forth by the event.
- 12. Cancellations can be made up to 24hrs prior to allocated booking time. If made within 24hrs of booking, a refund will not be issued unless otherwise discussed.
- 13. Participants and guardians must obey current COVID-19 rules as imposed by the Victorian Government at the time of the workshop.
- 14. Odyssey Sports may amend these terms and conditions at any time at its discretion. Any changes will be effective immediately upon posting on the website.
